

Notice of proposal to digitise articles published in SANHS Proceedings pre-1940

The Somerset Archaeology and Natural History Society proposes to scan articles in back issues of Proceedings and make them available in electronic form at a small charge through the Society's online shop. This will allow wider access to previously published papers and keep alive an archive of important scholarly work for the future.

It would exceed the resources available to the Society to identify all authors who have contributed to these articles and obtain their (or their Estate executors' where applicable) permission to republish their work electronically. The Society therefore asks any authors who object to their work being included in the electronic archive to let us know as soon as possible. SANHS will respect their decision, and, if necessary, their work will be omitted from the archive.

It is important that this notice is disseminated widely so we would be grateful if you could draw it to the attention of all your colleagues.
